Membership meeting

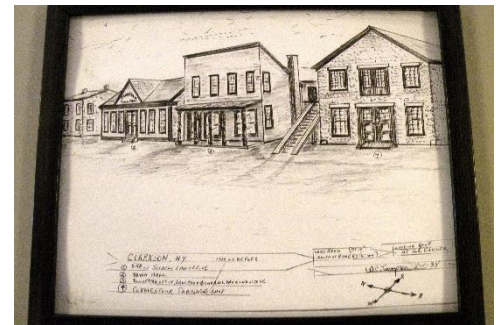
Our regular Membership Meetings will begin again on the first Wednesdays of October, November, and December.
